CERTIFICATIONS AND LICENSES

Mike has been certified by the American Board of Trial Advocates. In 1990, Mike was awarded Certificates of Special Competence in Personal Injury Trial Law and Civil Trial Law by the Texas Board of Legal Specialization. He was recertified in 1995, 2000 and 2005. He is licensed to practice in all Texas State Courts and before the United States District Courts for the Eastern, Western, Southern and Northern Districts of Texas. He is also licensed to practice before the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit.

PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION
