New standards needed for underride guards, IIHS says
Recent crash tests conducted by an auto insurance research 2010 passenger car crashing into the rear of three parked organization show that underride guards on tractor-
trailers can fail in relatively low-speed crashes, with deadly consequences.
Now the Insurance Institute for Highway Safety (IIHS) is petitioning the federal government to require stronger underride guards that will remain in place during a crash,
and to mandate guards for more large trucks and trailers. According to the IIHS, rear guards are supposed to reduce underride deaths and injuries when a passenger vehicle

ANSWERS TO LEGAL QUESTIONS

Question:
Is it illegal to unknowingly sell a recalled product at a garage sale?
Answer:
YES. Selling products, even used ones, which have been recalled or banned is a violation of the Consumer Product afety Improvement Act. Besides individuals holding garage or yard sales, this law applies to thrift or consignment tores, charities, flea markets, and to people to who sell on auction websites.
"Ignorance of the law is an excuse," warns a 27 page Consumer Product afety Commission reseller's handbook. This handbook available at www.cpsc.gov It summarizes the law for veryday people who sell used products.

Keep Children Safe in the Car

School is back in session which means you are busy shuttling your kids not just to and from school, but to gymnastics, soccer practice, football games, etc. Safety
is your No. 1 concern when it comes to is your No. 1 concern when it comes to
driving, and it's even more important when you're traveling with children. The proper car seat is crucial. Here are some proper car seat is crucial. Here are some
safety professionals' recommendations on how to protect your most precious cargo:

Check the safety label. Make sure it meets or exceeds federal safety requirements for carrying children.

Be wary of used seats. A previously owned seat that is more than six years old may not be safe. Look for missing parts, cracks, or other signs of wear and tear. Call the manufacturer to ask about durability and recalls.

Get the seat that fits your child. Infant seats are designed for children from birth to about $20-35$ pounds.

Some can be converted to hold a child up to about 40 pounds. Otherwise, you'll need a front-facing safety seat capable of holding children they they reach 40 pounds, and after the hit about 80 pounds, if necessary or desired. Keep careful track of how big your children grow.
Learn the safety belt test. Do the child's knees bend at the edge of a regular car seat? Does the belt ride low on his or her hips? Doe the shoulder belt re Des the child sit comfortably with a seat belt and sit comfortably with a seat belt an
shoulder strap correctly fastened? If any of the answers to these questions are no, keep the child in a safety seat until he or she has grown sufficiently enough to ride along with only a safety belt.

is also important to remember tha as your children grow, they learn how to unbuckle themselves from car seats, which proves to be not just dangerous fo the child, but a distraction to the driver atalled properly and that children are fastened securely.

Following these simple steps whe hoosing and using a child's safety seat heep your little ones as safe as possible and will keep you a happy parent.
